Sealed bids are solicited for: **Clark Township Harbor Improvements**, Cedarville, MI, Mackinac County, Michigan. The project includes construction of a 40'x40' Harbor Building, floating pier, site improvements, shoreline protection and upgrades, including rip rap and dock installation. Description: Five bid packages for harbor improvements and new facilities, per the construction documents. Contractors may bid on one package or multiple packages. The bid for each bid package shall be submitted in a separate envelope.

Bid Package 3: Driveways and Parking Lots

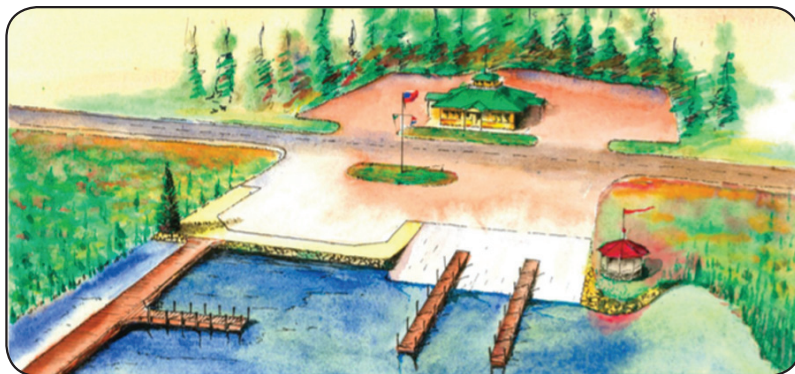
Bid Package 4: Landscaping and Sitework

Sealed Bids will be received by the Owner, at the address above, until 3:00 p.m. ET, August 30, 2018 at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Clark Township office at 207 N. Blindline Rd., Cedarville, MI. Envelopes shall be clearly marked, "**BID ENCLOSED, Cedarville Harbor Building Project**" on the outside envelope of sealed bid.

The Contract Documents may be examined at the office of **U.P. Engineers & Architects, Inc. at 707 Ashmun Street, Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan 49783**; and at the following Builders Exchanges: Marquette Builders Exchange, Grand Rapids Builders Exchange, Builders Exchange of Northwest Michigan, Inc. Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained from the office of **U.P. Engineers & Architects, Inc.**, address above, upon payment of two separate checks in the amount of \$120 for deposit (refundable) and \$120 (non-refundable) for each set. Documents may be obtained as a PDF file upon a non-refundable fee of \$40.

Questions during the bidding period shall be submitted via email to kermatinger@upea.com, with the subject line to include, Cedarville Harbor RFI, and the topic. Last day to submit questions is three days before the bid date. **BID SECURITY** – Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond payable to the Owner in an amount no less than five percent (5%) of the maximum bid as a guarantee that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute and file the Contract, Performance and Payment Bonds, and Insurance Certification, as required by the Contract Documents, within fifteen days after Notice of Award. Bid may not be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after bid deadline. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.



GOVERNMENT FUNDING

State or federal funds are being used to assist in construction and relevant State or federal requirements will apply. Bidders must comply with all requirements of 1976 PA 453 (Elliott-Larsen Civil Rights Act) and 1976 PA 220 (Persons with Disabilities Civil Rights Act), as amended. In accordance with these laws, all contracts you enter into must contain a covenant: The contractor and any subcontractors are not to discriminate against an employee or applicant for employment with respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment, or a matter directly or indirectly related to employment, because of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, marital status or a disability that is unrelated to the individual's ability to perform the duties of a particular job or position. A breach of this covenant will be regarded as a material breach of the contract and of your Project Agreement.
